On the occasion of the 22nd anniversary of the Verbier music festival, the Catholic University of Sacro Cuore (Piacenza) and the University of Lausanne take the chance to organize a seminar focused on tax issues related to artists and sportsmen, with the participation of the International Tax Entertainment Group (ITEG), a network of tax experts active in the entertainment sector, representing nine European jurisdictions (Belgium, France, Germany, Italy, Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Spain and UK).

The first part of the seminar is mainly aimed at investigating - from an international and European tax law perspective rules on reporting and withholding requirements imposed on withholding agents, such as clubs, orchestras and concert organizers.
